2	The member concerns of the Chamber desiring to change their representative shall intimate changes regarding name of representative to the Secretary General along with necessary proof.	18 th July, 2020 Saturday
3	The Secretary General shall display the provisional list of all members eligible to vote along with their National Tax Registration Number, Sales Tax Registration if applicable, the name and national identity card number of their representative at Notice Board and website of the Chamber.	22 nd July, 2020 Wednesday
4	The members who have any objection to the entries/changes in the list of voters shall send their objections in writing to the Secretary General.	29 th July, 2020 Wednesday
5	The Secretary General will intimate action on the objection or changes sent by members.	7 th August, 2020 Friday
6	Any member aggrieved by the decision of the Secretary General, taken in the preceding clause, may make a representation to the Election Commission.	10 th August, 2020 Monday
7	The Commission will decide the representation	13 th August. 2020 Thursday
8	Any person aggrieved by the decision of the Commission or where the Commission fails to decide the representation within the stipulated time mentioned in the preceding clause may appeal to the Regulator, and decision of the Regulator in this regard shall be final.	17 th August, 2020 Monday
9	The Regulator will decide the appeal.	27 th August, 2020 Thursday
10	The final list of voters shall be displayed at notice board and at website of the Chamber and shall also be submitted to the Regulator.	02 nd September, 2020 Wednesday

11	Any person who is eligible to contest the Election for the vacant posts of the Member Executive Committee shall send his nomination papers duly proposed, seconded by a duly registered voter and signed by the candidate, to the Secretary General on the prescribed form in accordance with the Articles of Association or Rules of the Chamber. In the same manner women entrepreneurs desiring to contest the election for the reserved seats in the Executive Committee for women will submit nomination papers.	4 th September, 2020 Friday
12	<p>a) Scrutiny of the nomination papers and letter of authority by the Commission. This clause ipso facto applies to the nominees of the women seats.</p> <p>b) Secretary General will provide a copy of final list of voters to each contesting candidate.</p> <p>c) Secretary General will circulate a list of Candidates whose papers have been declared valid and issue form of withdrawal to the said Candidates. This clause ipso facto applies to the Candidates of the women seats.</p>	5 th September, 2020 Saturday
13	The objection if any, to the nomination of candidates can be filed to the Election Commission. This clause ipso facto applies to the nominees of the women seats. Provided that the candidate for a particular seat will file objections for the candidate of the same seat and for the same class.	8 th September, 2020 Tuesday
14	The Election Commission will decide the objections filed under the preceding clause. This clause ipso facto applies to the nominees of the women seats.	10 th September, 2020 Thursday
15	Any Candidate, aggrieved by the decision of the Election Commission, taken under preceding clause, where the Commission fails to decide within the time stipulated in the preceding clause may file an appeal to the Regulator. This clause ipso facto applies to the nominees of the women seats.	12 th September 2020 Saturday
16	The Regulator shall decide the appeal filed under the preceding clause.	19 th September, 2020 Saturday
17	The Secretary General will receive withdrawal forms duly completed and signed by the nominee who wants to withdraw his/her name from the election.	21 st September, 2020 Monday
18	The commission will issue the final list of candidates.	22 nd September, 2020 Tuesday

EXPLANATION:

- 1) For the purpose of this schedule “Day” means working days and working hours of the Chamber on that day unless otherwise stated.
- 2) Note: All activities mentioned above are in accordance to the provisions of Rule 18 of the Trade Organizations Rules 2013. For more understanding and explanation please consult the Rule 18 and sub-rules.

All activities except polling on Sept 25 and 26, 2020 shall be performed during office hours which are:

- Monday to Thursday 09:00 am to 05:00 pm with one hours lunch and prayer break
- Friday 09:00 am to 05:00 pm with one and half hour lunch and prayer break
- Saturday 09:00 am to 02:00 pm without break
