6. STATEMENT OF ACCOUNTS

6.1 The Statement of Accounts was presented and approved by the house. The Secretary General put forth a proposal for the annual increase in the LCCI Annual Fee, which was seconded by the Senior Vice President (SVP). Due to prevailing inflationary pressures, it was agreed that the annual fee for the Corporate Class would be increased by Rs. 1080 and for the Associate Class by Rs. 300. This decision is slated to be an agenda item for the upcoming Annual General Meeting (AGM).

6.2 The President appealed to the house for generous donations to support flood affectees. The house unanimously approved a donation of Rs. 3 million for the flood affectees and allocated Rs. 10 million to the war fund.

8. LEGAL MATTER

8.1 The legal matters pertaining to LCCI were discussed. The Senior Vice President emphasized the critical importance of integrating these legal considerations into the daily operational framework of LCCI.

9. CONSTITUTION OF AD-HOC COMMITTEE ON STATUTORY REPORT

9.1 The President formally constituted an Ad-hoc Committee for the purpose of statutory reports. Mr. Shahid Nazir, Vice President, will chair this committee, with the assistance of Mr. Faheem-ur-Rehman Saigol, Mr. Tanvir Ahmad, Mr. Khurram Lodhi, and Mr. Imran Saleemi.

10 ISSUES OF TRADE & INDUSTRY & ANY OTHER ITEM

- 10.1 Mr. Rana Nisar Ahmad brought to attention several challenges related to port clearing processes. The Chair assured to take up these issues.
- 10.2 Mr. Khurram Lodhi underscored the critical need for expedited document attestation services from the Ministry of Foreign Affairs (MOFA). The house approved a fee of Rs. 2,000 per case for this service and establishment of a TCS counter at LCCI to facilitate the process.
- 10.3 Syed Salman Ali raised the issue of prolonged transit times at ports. The Chair asked Secretary-General to look into this matter.
- 10.4 Mr. Imran Saleemi discussed the imposition of substantial fines on businesses by the newly established Punjab Enforcement & Regulatory Authority in Pakistan (PERA). The house unanimously passed a resolution opposing these fines.
- 10.5 Mr. Irfan Ahmad Qureshi voiced concerns about the insufficient attention given to industrial issues, particularly within the engineering sector. He proposed a realignment of LCCI's efforts to enhance support for the industry. The Senior Vice President (SVP) acknowledged and supported these concerns, urging more robust efforts.
- 10.6 Mr. Shahid Nazir, Vice President, highlighted the severe economic challenges currently faced by the business community and emphasized the necessity of collective and unified efforts to overcome them.

The meeting concluded with a vote of thanks by the Vice President.
