### 3 APPROVAL OF MINUTES OF THE EC MEETING

#### **Discussion:**

The minutes of the previous Executive Committee meeting were presented by the Chair before the House. Mr. Kashif Anwar while saying that he was against any increase in the LCCI fees, sought clarification about EOGM minutes wherein it is mentioned that a 10 per cent increase would be made every subsequent year. The Secretary General, with the approval of the Chair, clarified that the approved increases of PKR 300 for Associate Members and PKR 1,080 for Corporate Members are effective for the current year only. Any proposal for an automatic annual 10% increase will require a separate resolution and approval through a future Extraordinary General Meeting (EOGM).

#### **Resolution:**

The House approved the minutes unanimously.

### 4 LIST OF ACTIVITIES

The List of Activities, attached herewith, was approved with great appreciation by the House.

### 5. STATEMENT OF ACCOUNTS

#### **Discussion:**

Mr. Kashif Anwar said that there is a need to tighten the belt as far as LCCI expenditures are concerned. The Chair assured that expenditure control measures would be duly reviewed.

#### **Resolution:**

The Statement of Accounts was approved unanimously by the House.

### 6. MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF THE STANDING COMMITTEE

#### **Discussion:**

The Minutes of the following Standing Committee, attached herewith, were presented before the House by order of the Chair in the meeting;

Mr. Ahad Amin Malik informed the House that in the first three months of this year **(October, November, and December, 2025)** 2000 new businesses got LCCI Membership which is a great achievement of the present regime. He commended the collective efforts of the Office-Bearers and Executive Committee.

**Resolution:**

The House approved the minutes unanimously with the condition that anything approved in the minutes, contrary to Chamber policy or LCCI Articles or having financial implications, will be considered "not approved." Moreover, all functions of the standing committees will be organized on a self-financed basis.

The Chair expressed special appreciation for Mr. Ahad Amin Malik and the entire Membership Committee for their hard work.

**7. DISCUSSION ON REPLY TO SHOW CAUSE NOTICE (SCN) SUBMITTED BY MIAN ABUZAR SHAD, FORMER PRESIDENT, LCCI**

**Discussion:**

- 7.1 The Secretary General presented before the House the EC Minutes and Resolution dated 03-12-2025, the Show Cause Notice (SCN) bearing No. LCCI/SECT/SCN/2025/402 dated 04-12-2025 issued by the Secretary General as directed under the said EC Resolution, the Application submitted by Mian Abuzar Shad dated 05-12-2025 thereby acknowledging the receipt of the SCN, the Reply by the Secretary General to Mian Abuzar Shad dated 06-12-2025 and the final reply to the SCN by Mian Abuzar Shad dated 08-12-2025.
- 7.2 The Chair directed the Secretary General to read out, before the house, the reply to the SCN issued to Mian Abuzar Shad dated 08-12-2025. The Secretary General read the reply and the Chair opened the house for discussion.
- 7.3 Mr. Kashif Anwar stated that, in his opinion, no individual has or should have the authority to misbehave with the Chair, irrespective of whether the Chair is right or wrong, and that any misconduct directed at the Chair or the three office-bearers is unacceptable and warrants an appropriate action. He reiterated that he and all members unequivocally condemn any form of misbehavior towards the Chair.
- 7.4 Mr. Tanveer Ahmed Sheikh, Senior Vice President said that the allegations in the reply to the show cause notice cannot be tolerated and should be condemned in all possible manners. The direct allegation that the President engineered the entire episode is unacceptable.

- 7.5 Rana Nisar Ahmed raised serious concerns regarding the conduct of Mian Abuzar Shad, stating that he had used highly inappropriate language against him and, despite repeated objections, continued to employ defamatory rhetoric. Rana Nisar Ahmad further stated that he personally visited Mian Abuzar Shad to address the matter but was met with false allegations, including a baseless public claim circulated via media that a foreign guest accompanying him had been mistreated at the Lahore Chamber, which he clarified was completely untrue, as he and Mr. Ehtisham-ul-Haq had extended full protocol and hospitality to the said guest. Rana Nisar Ahmed also highlighted a recurring pattern of misinformation by Mian Abuzar Shad, citing false claims of having provided fifteen transformers to Shah Alam Market when only two were approved, and falsely taking credit for constructing roads. He urged the Committee to take strict disciplinary action to end this persistent campaign of misinformation and misuse of privileged access to safeguard the dignity and integrity of the Lahore Chamber.
- 7.6 Mr. Khurram Lodhi said that Mr. Faheem ur Rehman Saigol is an elected President and expressed his full support to the Chair in this matter. He condemned the remarks of Mian Abuzar Shad about the Chair. Mr. Lodhi strongly endorsed the view that such conduct should not be tolerated and called for appropriate action to uphold the dignity of the Office of the President and the integrity of the Chamber.
- 7.7 Mr. Aamir Saeed Mian said that extensive discussions and initiatives had already been undertaken. He acknowledged the leadership of Mr. Faheem ur Rehman Saigol for patiently hearing the views of members. Mr. Aamir Saeed Mian strongly proposed the immediate termination of the membership of Mian Abuzar Shad. He further proposed that Mr. Qadri should also be barred from entering the Chamber premises. He stated that he has always spoken in favor of truth and justice, regardless of personal consequence, and that the time had come to close this chapter definitively.
- 7.8 Mr. Kashif Anwar expressed profound respect for the President and affirming that the President holds the office 24/7. He showed his full support for any action taken by the Executive Committee and confirmed that his vote and opinion stand with the Committee's decision. Mr. Kashif Anwar noted that the Executive Committee had already suspended the membership of Mian Abuzar Shad and his associated companies, and the Committee is now proceeding towards permanent termination of his membership. He sought procedural clarification that Executive Committee approval would necessitate convening an Extraordinary General Meeting (EOGM), followed by EOGM approval, and subsequent referral to the Director General, Trade Organizations (DGTO), for formal removal. He raised a legal question: if Mian Abuzar Shad holds membership across more than one company and his individual membership is terminated? Whether all associated companies would automatically be suspended, cancelled, or terminated. He further drew attention that respected fellow Executive Committee member Ms. Aamna Randhawa is affiliated with one of the companies owned by Mian Abuzar Shad, and expressed concern that termination of all

associated companies may inadvertently impact her membership status and position on the Executive Committee. Mr. Kashif Anwar strongly recommended that the Committee first obtain a formal legal opinion before proceeding with termination of associated companies, to ensure a legal solution is adopted in advance that protects Ms. Randhawa's membership and position. The house acknowledged the concerns raised and resolved to consult the Chamber's legal counsel urgently for a formal Legal opinion regarding the cascading effect of membership termination on associated companies and the status of Executive Committee members affiliated therewith. The President assured that all due process shall be followed and no member shall be unfairly disadvantaged.

- 7.9 The Secretary General apprised the Committee of the legal procedure, stating that once the Executive Committee adopts a decision today to terminate the membership of Mian Abuzar Shad, he shall have a period of thirty (30) days to make a written representation to the President of the Lahore Chamber of Commerce & Industry. The Secretary General explained that the President shall review the representation and render a decision thereafter. If the President is satisfied with the representation, the termination decision shall not be implemented. However, if the President is not satisfied and upholds the decision of the Executive Committee, the matter shall then require the convening of an Extraordinary General Meeting (EOGM) for final resolution. The Secretary General clarified that this procedural timeline provides sufficient opportunity for due process.
- 7.10 Mr. Khalid Usman stated that he wished to address the matter on moral grounds for record accuracy. While acknowledging the valid legal points raised by Mr. Kashif Anwar, he emphasized the importance of the moral dimension. Having worked closely with Mian Abuzar Shad for an entire year, he understood that actions may sometimes occur in the heat of the moment. However, upon reviewing Mian Abuzar Shad response which appeared to have been drafted through a lawyer. He observed a complete absence of remorse. Mr. Khalid Usman expressed that Mian Abuzar Shad should have tendered an unconditional apology before the institution, as the responsibility to uphold the dignity of the Chamber and its President applies equally to all, including past presidents. Had such an apology been offered, the unanimous opinion of the Executive Committee might have been different. Instead, the response extinguished any sympathy that may have existed and left no room for mediation. He stressed that while dissent may be exercised politically, as demonstrated by Mr. Kashif Anwar at the conducting of EOGM, it must remain within institutional bounds. Mr. Khalid Usman asserted that the institution now has no choice but to act, and if individuals are permitted to act according to their whims, the Chamber would descend into chaos. He emphasized that the business community is passing through one of the most difficult periods in Pakistan's history, and this is not the time to settle personal scores. The people have placed immense trust in the Chamber's leadership, and the demand of the situation requires that the wisdom of the Executive Committee prevails. He assured the house full support with the decision of the House. Regarding the legal question of associated companies, Mr. Khalid Usman sought clarification on whether Ms. Aamna Randhawa affiliation with one of Mr. Abuzar Shad companies is as CEO or as a nominee director, as this distinction carries legal implications.

- 7.11 The Secretary General responded to the queries raised, providing clarification that the venerable Director General Trade Organizations (DGTO) respects the mandate of the Chamber. Concerning Ms. Aamna Randhawa, the Secretary General assured the Committee that her position may be reviewed and all necessary verifications can be undertaken to ensure her status remains unaffected. On the scope of expulsion, the Secretary General conveyed the House the Legal Advisor's opinion that Mian Abuzar Shad may be expelled from the membership of the Lahore Chamber of Commerce & Industry, and this expulsion would apply to Mian Abuzar Shad in his individual capacity through any and all business concerns, including but not limited to any proprietorship, partnership firm, or private/public company where he represents the entity or holds a membership interest, clarifying that this scope encompasses all entities associated with Mian Abuzar Shad, consistent with the suspension previously imposed.
- 7.12 Mr. Irfan Ahmed Qureshi expressed serious concern regarding the language used in the letter, particularly the manner in which the word "President" has been employed, noting that it reflects a distinct lack of respect. He questioned how the Executive Committee, which elected one of its own members to the office of President, could be expected to consider a representation that fails to accord basic respect to that office, pointing out that the letter does not contain any phrase such as "Respected President" and appears to have been drafted by what he termed a "third-class counseling" whose language contains no element of respect. He emphasized that the Executive Committee cannot entertain language that does not uphold the dignity of the President's office.
- 7.13 Mr. Amir Ali thanked the President and proposed that while there is unanimous opinion that Mian Abuzar Shad should not remain a member and should be expelled along with his companies, there exist underlying grievances behind this consensus that need to be voiced.
- 7.14 Mr. Shoban Akhtar accused the former president Mian Abuzar Shad of contradictions between his statements and actions, alleging misconduct including securing water supply from his own company and writing complaints against the leadership, including to the DGTO. Mr. Akhtar stated that they tolerated these actions out of respect for the Chair's office and refrained from any disrespect. However, he asserted that the individual continued his behavior post-tenure, disrespecting the 48,000 members. He argued that forgiving such conduct would set a dangerous precedent, allowing anyone to seek forgiveness after venting their grievances. Consequently, Mr. Akhtar requested that the strictest possible legal punishment be imposed, including the termination of all his companies' affiliations with the Chamber. He further appealed to former President Mr. Kashif Anwar, emphasizing that this matter concerns the honor of the Lahore Chamber and should not be viewed through a political lens, urging him to speak against the individual in question for the sake of the Chamber's dignity.
- 7.15 Sheikh Fayyaz Ahmad acknowledged that while all Executive Committee members are duty-bound to protect the Chair. He stated that if the leadership of the three alliances engages in backdoor diplomacy without taking the EC members into confidence, he would be the first to object and protest, as such actions would render this seat meaningless. Sheikh Fayyaz Ahmad then turned to the role of the media over the past year, questioning what

action the three alliances' leadership took against a media person who repeatedly disrespected the President's office. He asked why the leadership has not yet clarified what steps were taken to stop that mistreatment. He concluded by stating that this is the moment for the entire EC to decide, assuring that the EC will stand united on the decision regarding Mian Abuzar Shad but also demanding that the leadership demonstrate its stance on these other activities as well.

- 7.16 Syed Salman Ali stated that Mr. Faheem ur Rahman Saigol, President LCCI is highly honorable and holds a position of great respect for them. He acknowledged that while the action in question was wrong, it is also important to consider the other aspect if the media is responsible for certain behaviors, then appropriate action should be taken against them as well.
- 7.17 Mr. Amir Saeed Mian stated his position that Mian Abuzar Shad had committed a wrongdoing and, given the presence of witnesses Rana Nisar Ahmed and Mr. Ehtisham ul Haq alongside the existing evidence, asserted that no apology should be entertained and that the matter should not be reconsidered.

### **Resolution:**

After concluding the above discussions, the house unanimously, without the dissent of a single member, resolved that

**WHEREAS**, the Member was charged with a direct assault on the President by violent physical trespass into the President's office on December 2, 2025;

**AND WHEREAS**, the EC has meticulously reviewed the following evidence:

1. **Direct Eyewitness Testimony:** Consistent and corroborated accounts from Senior Vice President Mr. Tanvir Ahmad Sheikh, and former President Mian Mohammad Ali, Mr. Ehtasham ul Huq, and others, confirming the Member's verbal abuse, physical threats, and assault on the President by violently trespassing the President's office within the Chamber premises.
2. **Police Record:** Application (Diary) No. RRC-02/12/2025-3933 filed with Police Station Race Course, Lahore.
3. **Written Admission:** The written reply filed by Mian Abuzar Shad, wherein he has formally confessed/admitted to the occurrence of the untoward event and his entry into the President's office to engage in a heated exchange, thereby corroborating the core facts of the physical confrontation.

**AND WHEREAS**, in accordance with the principles of natural justice and the LCCI Articles of Association, the Member was afforded a "Due Opportunity to be Heard" and "Explain his position". While the Member opted not to avail himself of the opportunity for a personal/oral

hearing before this Committee, he did submit a detailed written reply/explanation which has been fully considered by the House;

**AND WHEREAS,** the Executive Committee finds the Member's explanation to be unsatisfactory and insufficient to mitigate the gravity of the proven misconduct. The EC further finds that the Member's conduct is "derogatory to the Chamber" and "contrary to the objects of the Chamber" as defined under Article 14(i) and Article 12(v);

**NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS UNANIMOUSLY RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:**

1. **EXPULSION:** That Mian Abuzar Shad be and is hereby **EXPELLED** from the membership of the Lahore Chamber of Commerce and Industry (LCCI) with immediate effect.
2. **SCOPE OF EXPULSION:** This expulsion shall apply to Mian Abuzar Shad in his individual capacity through any and all business concerns, including but not limited to any proprietorship, partnership firm, or private/public company where he represents the entity or holds a membership interest.
3. **ENTRY INTO THE CHAMBER:** The Member's entry into the Chamber premises is strictly prohibited.
4. **DIRECTIONS TO SECRETARY GENERAL:** The Secretary General is directed to strike the name of Mian Abuzar Shad and his associated business concerns from the Register of Members and to duly intimate the Regulator/Director General Trade Organizations (DGTO) Islamabad of this final decision of the Chamber.

This agenda item involved misconduct against the President, therefore, the President recused from deliberations and voting. The discussions were made and resolution passed by the remaining members unanimously.

## **8. RESIGNATION & CO-OPTION OF EC MEMBER**

- 8.1 The Secretary General informed the members that Mr. Khalid Usman, former Senior Vice President and Executive Committee member, had tendered his resignation. The House approved the resignation of Mr. Khalid Usman and after due deliberations as to the merit, legal suitability and class requirement, the House unanimously co-opted Ch. Muhammad Mohsin Bashir Ali, corporate member LCCI, as a new member of the Executive Committee, under section 161(2) of the Companies Act 2017. The Secretary General was directed to obtain a formal consent letter from the Ch. Muhammad Mohsin Bashir Ali.
- 8.2 The Chair appreciated Mr. Khalid Usman for his positive input for the wellbeing of Business Community of Pakistan and LCCI. The house gave a standing ovation to Mr. Khalid Usman.

8.3 The Chair asked Mr. Amir Ali to brief the house about his recognition. Mr. Amir Ali informed the house that as an honorary goodwill Ambassador of Belt and Road, he has been conferred by an Award, Reward and Shield at Governor House in recognition of his services as Financial Advisor. He also informed the house that he is the only Pakistani who received this award. The house congratulates him on his recognition.

The meeting concluded with a vote of thanks by the Vice President.
