1	The Secretary General shall display election schedule on the notice board of LCCI, website and submit a copy to the D.G.T.O.	15 th July Friday
2	The member concerns of the Chamber desiring to change their representative shall intimate changes regarding name of representative to the Secretary General along with necessary proof.	19 th July Tuesday
3	The Secretary General shall display the provisional list of all members eligible to vote along with their National Tax Registration Number, Sales Tax Registration if applicable, the name and national identity card number of their representative at Notice Board and website of the Chamber.	23 rd July Saturday
4	The members who have any objection to the entries/changes in the list of voters shall send their objections in writing to the Secretary General.	30 th July Saturday
5	The Secretary General will intimate action on the objection or changes sent by members.	5 rd August Friday
6	Any member aggrieved by the decision of the Secretary General, taken in the preceding clause, may make a representation to the Election Commission.	10 th August Wednesday
7	The Election Commission will decide the representation.	13 th August Saturday
8	Any person aggrieved by the decision of the Election Commission or where the Commission fails to decide the representation within the stipulated time mentioned in the preceding clause may appeal to the Regulator, and decision of the Regulator in this regard shall be final.	17 th August Wednesday
9	The Regulator will decide the appeal.	27 th August Saturday
10	The final list of voters shall be displayed at notice board and at website of the Chamber and shall also be submitted to the Regulator.	30 th August Tuesday
11	Any person who is eligible to contest the Election for the vacant posts of the Member Executive Committee shall send his nomination papers duly proposed, seconded by a duly registered voter and signed by the candidate, to the Secretary General on the prescribed form in accordance with the Articles of Association or Rules of the Chamber. In the same manner women entrepreneurs desiring to contest the election for the reserved seats in the Executive Committee for women will submit nomination papers.	3 rd September Saturday
12	(A) Scrutiny of the nomination papers, letter of authority, Board resolution by the Election Commission. This clause ipso facto applies to the nominees of the women seats. (B) Display of list of nominees whose papers have been declared valid and the forms of withdrawal to the said nominees. This clause ipso-facto applies to the nominees of the women seats. (C) The secretary General shall provide a copy of final list of voters to each contesting candidate except the candidate of women seats, as their Electoral College is the elected Executive Committee.	5 th September Monday

13	The objection if any, to the nomination of candidates can be filed to the Election Commission. This clause ipso facto applies to the nominees of the women seats. Provided that the candidate for a particular seat will file objections for the candidate of the same seat and for the same class.	6 th September Tuesday
14	The Election Commission will decide the objections filed under the preceding clause. This clause ipso facto applies to the nominees of the women seats.	8 th September Thursday
15	Any candidate, aggrieved by the decision of the Election Commission, taken under preceding clause, where the Commission fails to decide within the time stipulated in the preceding clause may file an appeal to the Director General. This clause ipso facto applies to the nominees of the women seats.	10 th September Saturday
16	The Regulator shall decide the appeal preferred under the proceeding clause.	19 th September Monday
17	The Secretary General will receive the withdrawals requests bearing true signature of the nominee who want to withdraw from the Election.	20 th September Tuesday
18	The Election Commission will issue the final list of candidates.	21 th September Wednesday
19	(A) The polling at the registered office of the Chamber for Corporate Class. (B) Counting of votes shall take place immediately after the polling hours under the supervision of polling officer in the presence of polling agents of the candidates, if any at the designated site. (C) The Election Commission shall declare the provisional results.	26 th September Monday
20	(A) The polling at the registered office of the Chamber for Associate Class. (B) Counting of votes shall take place immediately after the polling hours under the supervision of polling officer in the presence of polling agents of the candidates, if any at the designated site. (C) The Election Commission shall declare provisional results. (D) The Election Commission will conduct election for the seat reserved for Women Entrepreneurs. (E) Provisional results shall be declared by the Election Commission, about the women reserved seat.	27 th September Tuesday
21	(A) Any member elected by General Body in voting as member of EC shall send his nomination for election as an office bearer duly proposed and seconded by an elected E.C. member and signed by the candidate to the Election Commission. (B) Scrutiny of the nomination papers for the election of office bearers by the Election Commission. (C) Display of final list of candidate.	28 th September Wednesday
22	Polling for the election of office bearers.	29 th September Thursday
23	Announcement of election results in General Meeting called for this purpose.	30 th September Friday

EXPLANATION:

- 1) For the purpose of this schedule “Day” means working days and working hours of the Chamber on that day unless otherwise stated.
- 2) Any activity falls on a holiday is scheduled on the day next following the holiday(s)
- 3) Date of activity number 6 has been adjusted due to Ashura Holidays From 7th August to 8th August 2022.
- 4) Nomination paper without election fee Rs. 50,000/-(Non-Refundable) will not be accepted.
- 5) Polling Hours will be from 9 am to 5 pm without break which can be extended on the direction of Election Commission.

If for any reason any candidate or member does not receive any of the communication of the Secretary General in connection with the election, the election proceedings shall not be invalidated.
